DPG team members provide strategic counsel and issue management. They also sign on behalf of AZBio on key measures affecting our industry as our contract lobbyist. At the national level, AZBio often works in partnership with BIO, AdvaMed, MDMA, PhRMA and patient advocacy organizations.
