Launched in 2021, the Sonoran Living Health Innovation Spotlights public information campaign is a series of 1-minute and 4-minute segments that are co-produced by AZBio and ABC15 (KNXV-Phoenix). Each segment focuses on a health challenge or innovation opportunity and then spotlights an Arizona based organization working in this area. Segments air on ABC15 and CW61 (KASW-Phoenix). The program is expected to generate over 1 million impressions in 2023 based on Nielsen projections in the 25 and older demographic.


